## Purpose of the ministry

#### What the role involves

- 1. 4th Thursday of each month 2:15-4pm.
- 2. How often do we meet? Monthly
- 3. How much time commitment is required per meeting? 1-2 hours
- 4. What is the role of a volunteer? To chat to guests and a willingness to take a turn in leading or speaking on a given topic. Cake makers and sound or projection volunteers also much appreciated.
- 5. Is preparation required for meetings? Yes, preparation with others when taking a turn to lead or speak perhaps once or twice a term.
- 6. What training is provided? A termly team meeting and working alongside other volunteers..

### Typical "SHAPE" Profile

Spiritual Gifts (see eg Romans 12:3-8)	Someone with a loving servant heart; with a quiet confidence to encourage and teach others.
Heart for (zeal for a need or cause)	Sharing your faith in Jesus and helping others to grow in their walk with the Lord.
Abilities/skills (from education, work or life)	A good listener; a servant heart; ability to use creative and visual ways of sharing the gospel.
Personality (extrovert/introvert, task or team, detail or big picture)	Someone with a warm personality and interest in others. Ability and willingness to work with others as part of a team.
Experiences (good ones or painful ones if relevant here)	We welcome those who are honest and genuine as they talk about their ups and downs in life.
