

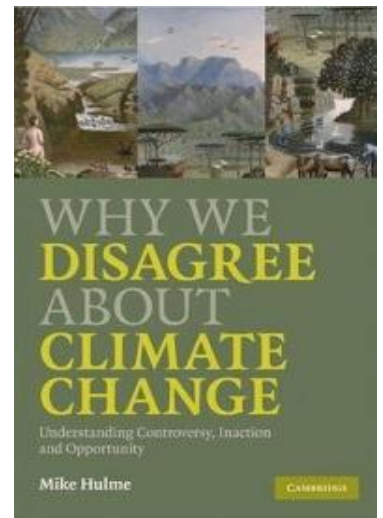
Why We Disagree About Climate Change: Science, Politics, Religion
