

Events Catering Team Volunteer Profile

Purpose of the ministry

Within Holy Trinity, we seek to know Christ better and make Him known by serving others through hospitality at an event where people will have the opportunity to grow in their faith and/or hear about Christ for the first time.

What the role involves

1. Time and day of team activity or meeting Depends on meeting/event
2. How often do we meet? Varies on meeting/event
3. How much time commitment is required? More than 3 hours
4. What is the role of a volunteer? As part of a team assist with planning, preparing, setting up and down for hospitality and catering for an event. If applicable purchase ingredients, prepare and cook the meal in the church kitchen applying 'clean as you go' principles, clean and sanitise kitchen and equipment used to prepare the food as per Food Safety requirements.
5. Is preparation required for meeting/event? Yes, there would be preparation how much would depend on your role in the team.
6. What training is provided? Food Hygiene course (online). Training to use oven and dishwasher, and/or if required training can be offered in terms of assistance of preparing and cooking food in church kitchen.
7. Is a DBS safeguarding check required? No
(If you are working with an under 18 there should be 2 adults and at least 1 should have a DBS)

Spiritual Gifts

(see eg Romans 12:3-8)

A serving attitude, encouragement, diligence

Heart for...

(zeal for a need or cause)

Welcome and fellowship – to make people feel they have been looked after whilst attending meeting/event.

Abilities/skills

(from education, work or life)

Any or all of the following: Planning, purchasing, if applicable preparing and/or cooking food on time, leading a team, working in a team, serving.
Up to date food hygiene certificate.

Personality

(extrovert/introvert, task or team, detail or big picture)

Love for serving and helping others, friendly and cheerful.

Experiences

(good ones or painful ones if relevant here)

Any interaction with people within work or personal life.
Previous catering experience useful but not a requirement.
