

Sound Team Volunteer Profile

Purpose of the ministry

Within Holy Trinity, we seek to know Christ better and make Him known by ensuring the congregation can hear all aspects of the service by operating the sound equipment.

What the role involves

- Time and day of team activity or meeting.
 Sunday Morning – 8.45am - end of service, plus 10 mins post service;
 Sunday Evening – 5.30pm – end of service plus 15 mins post service.
 Ideally it would be 2 duties per month
- 2. How often do we meet? Other
- 3. How much time commitment is required per meeting? 2-3 hours
- 4. What is the role of a volunteer? To operate the sounddesk during the band rehearsal and service. This means arriving in time to setup basic mic requirements as the band arrive.
- 5. Is preparation required for meetings? No
- 6. What training is provided? Full 1:1 training will be provided.
- 7. Is a DBS safeguarding check required? No

H eart for (zeal for a need or cause)	Ensuring that the congregation can hear the service content as required at the appropriate time in such a way as to avoid distraction from worship.
Abilities/skills (from education, work or life)	Ideally someone that has previously used a soundesk or has a technical leaning
P ersonality	Flexible, alert, team player
