

# Sunday refreshments – AM/PM Teams Volunteer Profile

## **Purpose of the ministry**

Within Holy Trinity, we seek to know Christ better and make Him known by providing refreshments after church services, so as to help create an environment of fellowship for the congregation and welcome for visitors

#### What the role involves

- 1. Time and day of team activity or meeting Sundays AM or PM half hour before service, through to one hour after service.
- 2. How often do we meet? Monthly
- 3. How much time commitment is required per meeting? 2-3 hours
- 4. What is the role of a volunteer? Assist in serving refreshment (tea, coffee, biscuits) and tidying afterwards
- 5. Is preparation required for meetings? No
- 6. What training is provided? Support and direction from the team leader
- 7. Is a DBS safeguarding check required? No

NB Each refreshments team serves on a fixed Sunday once per month, either morning or evening – volunteer can specify preferences (AM or PM, and which Sunday(s) of month convenient)

## Typical "SHAPE" Profile

Sometimes a certain kind of person is better suited to one role than to another. What might a typical volunteer look like in this area of serving?

<b>S</b> piritual Gifts (see eg Romans 12:3-8)	Service, encouragement, diligence
<b>H</b> eart for (zeal for a need or cause)	Welcome and fellowship. – to make everyone feel they have been looked after whilst attending our church services
Abilities/skills (from education, work or life)	Common sense – awareness of health and safety in a kitchen environment Practical skills - able to make tea and/or coffee following instruction
Personality (extrovert/introvert, task or team, detail or big picture)	Cheerfulness – able to work as part of a team in a busy environment  Eye for detail – able to make sure that refreshments are provided promptly and the kitchen left tidy afterwards
Experiences (good ones or painful ones if relevant here)	None required – support will be provided as part of a team.
